



Vojvodina Tour Full day

BELGRADE–GRGETEG–KRUSEDOL–SREMSKI KARLOVCI–NOVI SAD–BELGRADE

After breakfast, departure to Monastery Grgeteg. The exact year of the construction of the monastery is not known, but it is assumed that was built between 1459 and 1521. Proceed to Monastery Krusedol, which was built between 1509 and 1514. The Monastery Krusedol is one of the most important monasteries in Fruska Gora, according to its historical and cultural role, the wealth of the treasury of the monastery, the famous iconostasis and frescoes and other relics. After visiting the monasteries, we continue our trip to Sremski Karlovci, where the one could enjoy the short walk through the city, and also the view to the Patriarchy Court – the most monumental building of the 19th century in Vojvodina, Saborna church – one of the most beautiful example of the architecture of the 18th century, Gymnasium of Karlovci, Magistracy, Roman-Catholic church, fountain Four lions. Visit to the Museum of beekeeping and winery Zivanovic. Honey and wine tasting. Proceed to Novi Sad. Walking tour and sightseeing tour: Synagogue, Serbian National Theater, Square of Freedom with City Hall, monument of Svetozar Miletic and the Name of Mary Roman-Catholic church; continue the walk through the Street Zmaj Jovina to the Bishop's Palace, then proceed to Danube street to Danube park. Lunch at local restaurant. Afterward, optional visit to the Museum of Vojvodina, followed by a walk to the pier and visit to the monument and quay of Victims of the raid. Proceed to the symbol of Novi Sad, fortification which acquired its present appearance in the 18th century and was one of the main strategic points towards Turkey, Petrovaradin fortress. Return to Belgrade. Overnight at the hotel.

Tour includes:

- transfer as per itinerary with mini van or bus depending on number of participants; ;
- sightseeing as per the itinerary;
- licensed local English speaking guide;
- entrance fees for Monastery's and Beekeeping Museum and Winery Zivanovic in Sremski Karlovci with honey and wine tasting,
- lunch at local restaurant,
- organization costs.

Tour do not includes:

- tips for guide and driver,
- drink during the meal,
- personal expenses;
- other costs not included in program.
